Arkansas Association for Developmental Education (ArkADE), an affiliate of the National Association for Developmental Education (NADE), will award a \$500 scholarship. Applicant must have completed twelve hours of college coursework with at least three credits of developmental coursework. This coursework to include courses in remedial English or mathematics, college reading skills improvement, and remedial study skills. Applicant must have maintained a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 on all completed coursework. Applicant must be enrolled in an Arkansas higher education institution for at least 6 credit hours during the 2016 Fall term. A student who has completed a college degree is not eligible to apply for the ArkADE scholarship.

 - a. Completed application form.**
 - b. A letter of recommendation from a faculty member or faculty advisor at the applicant's college or university.**
 - c. A personal essay, minimum of 1 1/2 pages to a maximum of 2 pages, describing their educational and career goals and the challenges faced as a college student, including unmet financial needs. State the impact developmental education courses and learning support have had on progressing toward goals.**
 - d. A current official college transcript where cumulative GPA through May 2016 is indicated.**
 - e. Verification from Registrar's Office certifying Fall 2016 enrollment and credit hours.**
