

# BASIC POLICE TRAINING COURSE SUPPLY LIST

(Supplies and PT gear should be available on a daily basis)

- 1) Dark navy or black BDU style pants with a black belt. You will be issued 2 LETA t-shirts.
- 2) Black boots - It is recommended that one pair of boots be kept in parade condition for inspection, graduation, or any other event requiring a dress uniform. A second pair should be kept which are in good condition but do not reach the level of Class A appearance. The second pair may be worn on the range, and during other hands-on training activities where scuffing might occur.
- 3) Semi-automatic pistol with exterior safety with hammer blocking mechanism; decocking mechanism; or full time double action. (9 mm /.40 / .45 / 357 Sig)
- 4) Duty belt and holster in either leather or nylon. Holsters must be weapon specific. **Crossdraw, shoulder, and competition holsters are prohibited.**
- 5) Minimum of three magazines
- 6) Flashlight
- 7) Baton
- 8) Handcuffs and key
- 9) Padlock with two (2) keys, or combination lock
- 10) Rainwear
- 11) Quality Running Shoes
- 12) Black shorts or sweats (for Physical Fitness & Defensive Tactics). Shorts should be mid-thigh or longer.
- 13) A dress uniform will be needed for photographs.
- 14) Toiletries (Bed linen, towels & washcloths are provided by motel)
- 15) 16 ounces to 1-liter plastic container for drinking water during physical activities, etc.
- 16) Computer/Device with internet access and a web browser. (Firefox, Chrome, Safari or Internet Explorer 9+; may also need Flash, QuickTime or Acrobat Reader) And a flash drive.

## Recommended Equipment List for Range Operations

- Baseball-style hat
- Comfortable boots/shoes
- Clear eye protection
- Hearing protection
- Water/Gatorade
- Flashlight
- Raingear
- Band-Aids
- Ibuprofen/pain reliever
- Insect repellent
- Sun block
- Lip balm
- Warm headgear
- Thick wool socks
- Quality waterproof footwear
- Cleaning kit to include:
  - Boresnake cleaning brush
  - CLP cleaning chemical (do NOT use Remoil)
  - Rags
  - Old toothbrush
  - Q-tips
  - carbon scraper

You must be prepared to qualify in any weather condition. The only weather that closes range operation is lightning and tornadoes. Be prepared for strong winds, rain, and snow. In cold weather, it is strongly recommended that you dress in layers with the outer layer being waterproof. It is NOT recommended to drink many diuretics during range week. You will be outdoors with no climate control for several days. Plan ahead and try to be as comfortable as possible. This will increase your chance of qualifying.
